- I. **CALL TO ORDER AND ANNOUNCE A QUORUM IS PRESENT:**
With a quorum of the Alton City Commission present, Mayor Salvador Vela called the meeting to order at 7:31 pm.

 1. **Solicit input from the public on proposed Budget FY 2018-2019.**

1. Consider and approve an Interlocal Agreement for Police Services between the City of Alton and the Mission Consolidated Independent School District.

Jorge Arcaute, City Manager stated that the agreement is a renewal for police services to the schools on South Los Ebanos. Staff recommends approval. Motion to approve was moved Mayor Pro Tem Arturo Galvan Jr and seconded by Commissioner Richard Arevalo. Motion carried 5-0.

2. Consider and approve establishment of the “Federal Asset Forfeiture Fund”, a Special Revenue type fund; its corresponding new bank account at the Lone Star National Bank, City’s official depository, and to authorize the Commission members and City Manager as signer’s of such account.

Jorge Arcaute, City Manager stated the establishment of the special revenue fund is needed to deposit equitable sharing funds collected over time. Staff recommends approval. Motion to approve was moved Mayor Pro Tem Arturo Galvan Jr and seconded by Commissioner Richard Arevalo. Motion carried 5-0.
